### Specifications for Halter Classes – Friday September 24 and Saturday, September 25, 2010

- The BC Sporthorse competition is a Horse Council British Columbia Recognized Show.
- Rules of Equine Canada will be used as guidelines for classes being judged.
- Classes open to ALL Sport Horse/Pony Types. Pony size: Up to 14'2 – Height verification required (Equine Canada Card)
- Line Classes – ALL to be shown in plain snaffle bridle. Weanlings and yearlings may be shown in a leather halter. All reins to be held in handlers' hand for uniformity of presentation – no double rein allowed.  
Dress Code - Handlers to be suitably attired. **NO** jeans, shorts, T-Shirts and baseball caps.  
Exhibitors not correctly attired may be excused from the class.
- All horses/ponies must be braided
- Whip length for Halter Classes – 30" maximum.
- Junior Handlers/Riders will not be allowed to exhibit Stallions.
- Unmanageable horses/ponies will be excused.
- Photocopies of appropriate papers to be enclosed.
- Line Classes to be judged on conformation, quality, size, substance, soundness, general impression and suitability to become, or apparent ability to produce quality athletes. Horses/Ponies will be judged in a straight line at a walk, trot and then standing.
- Show Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes, which do not fill to their satisfaction.
- 3 Entries constitutes a class.

**LEAD LINE:** Riders 8 years of age and under – Sunday following lunch break.

### Specifications for Performance Classes – Sunday, September 26, 2010

- Dress Code – Correct English attire required for Performance Classes.
- All riders **MUST** wear ASTM or BSI approved helmets while riding on show grounds – this includes Stallion Parade.
- A reminder that competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.
- No flash noseband nor martingales allowed.
- No boots or leg wraps allowed.
- Whip length for Performance – Dressage Type Suitability 47" maximum, Hunter/Jumper 30" maximum.
- No whips allowed in Road and Show Hack .
- HORSE/PONIES' AGE - referred to in Divisions are as of January 1, 2010
- JUNIOR HORSE/PONY - 5 years and under
- YOUTH RIDERS' AGE - 13 Years and Under - as of January 1, 2010
- JUNIOR RIDERS' AGE - 14 to 18 Years- as of January 1, 2010
- AMATEUR RIDERS' AGE - 19 Years and Over- as of January 1, 2010

**NOTE:** Same horse and rider combination to qualify for Year End Awards.

- Show Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes which do not fill to their satisfaction. – 3 Entries constitutes a class.
- Any complaints must be in writing with a \$ 50.00 cash deposit. Show Committee will make the final decision.
- Abuse of horses/ponies will not be tolerated, exhibitor will be required to leave and forfeit their entry fees.
- Unruly Horses/Ponies whose actions threaten to endanger other exhibitors or their horses/ponies will be required to leave the ring.
- Unsportsmanlike activity will not be tolerated. Exhibitor will be required to leave and forfeit their entry fees.  
All exhibitors must be a member of B.C. Horse Council. A copy of your Membership to be included with your entry form.
- Any horse/pony entered in any class at this competition may, while on the competition grounds be selected for equine medication control testing.
- Entry fees shall be refunded ONLY upon presentation of a certificate of disability from a qualified Veterinarian to the Show Secretary prior to the show date and before the first class in which the horse/pony is entered. There will be NO refund on Stabling.
- There will be a Steward on site.

**NO** martingales or flash nosebands.

Riding crop allowed – 30" maximum

## English Pleasure

Double bridle, Pelham, Snaffle or Kimberwick .

**NO** martingales or flash nosebands.

## Hunter under Saddle

Double bridle, Pelham, Snaffle or Kimberwick.

**NO** martingales or flash nosebands.

## Dressage Type Suitability

Snaffle bridle flash noseband may be used. **NO** martingales.

Riding crop allowed – 120 cm or 47" maximum

## Show Hack and Road Hack (No whips allowed)

Double bridles, Pelham, Snaffle or Kimberwick.

**NO** martingales or flash nosebands.

## Whip Length for Halter Classes

30" maximum

## Line Classes

All reins to be held in handlers' hand for

Uniformity of presentation -

No double rein allowed

**OPEN TO ALL HORSES – regardless of breed.**

Horses will be judged on conformation, quality, size, substance, soundness, general impression and way of going. Horses will be judged in a straight line at a walk, trot and then standing. **Horses to enter clockwise into arena.**

**Broodmare** - Is a female horse, three years or older who is in foal or has produced a foal in the current year – (foal need not be shown with the dam) **Broodmares are to be braided.**

**Yeld Mare** – Is a female horse, three years or older who did not produce a foal in the current year, but who has been bred to produce a foal in the following year. Certificate of service as proof of breeding must accompany the entry for Yeld Mares.

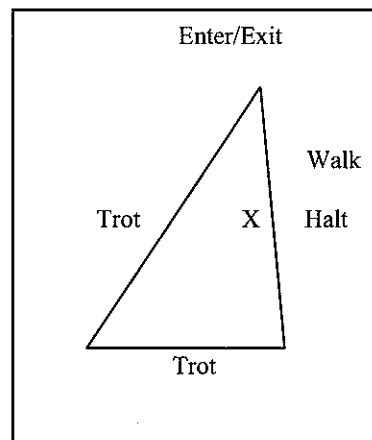
