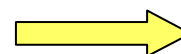

<sup>1</sup>**Equine Canada Membership** Equine Canada our national equestrian federation develops national programs for all Canadian equestrians and works in partnership with Horse Council on many issues. This membership is now **required** for all Horse Council BC members. To read more about EC, go to [www.equinecanada.ca](http://www.equinecanada.ca).

<sup>2</sup>**Members Named Perils** insurance covers the death of an owned horse resulting from fire, lightning or collision/overturn of a conveyance in which a horse was being transported. This insures up to a maximum of \$4,000 which can be applied regardless of the number of horses owned. Losses are restricted to one claim per year.

<sup>3</sup>**Enhanced Personal Liability** provides for the **NON-COMMERCIAL** not-for-profit care, custody and control of up to a maximum of 3 non-owned horses in **any** environment, e.g. emergency boarding situations, neighbourly housing of horses.

<sup>4</sup>**Additional Accident, Death & Dismemberment (A.D.D.)** provides an **ADDITIONAL** \$50,000 Principal Sum A.D.D. including benefit for Fracture & Dental.

<sup>5</sup>**Travel (Out of Province/Country)** provides \$1,000,000 out of province/country coverage for emergency medical/hospitalization.

<sup>6</sup>**Members Tack** insures tack & equipment from loss or damage anywhere in North America. Limit - \$2500 (\$500 deductible). Does not cover clothing or protective equipment worn by riders, wear & tear/abuse, mysterious disappearance or horse drawn vehicles.

<sup>7</sup>**The Ride and Drive Program** is a recreational benefit program aimed at BC equestrians to record the hours that they spend riding and driving, either for fun, competition, schooling, therapy or just any time spent in the saddle or on the cart.

<sup>8</sup>**PPHJ** has been a long time affinity partner of HCBC providing members with our monthly newsletter. HCBC provides its member newsletter through the PPHJ, but each member is responsible for the mailing costs.
